(Please be advised that first application Block Party Permit requests will be denied if you do not have a petition with at least fifty percent of the neighboring residents. Petitions are valid for five years, after which time a new Petition will be required.)

Barricades issued by the Department of Public Works must be utilized to secure streets. The Sponsor will be responsible for the non-refundable permit fee of \$10.00 and a barricade deposit of \$60.00 for the use of the barricades. The Sponsor will be charged \$60.00 per barricade if the barricades are returned in a damaged condition. The Sponsor (or designated representative) must pick up and return the barricades at the Greenfield Yard, 2951 Greenfield Road, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. on the Friday before and return them no later than the following Tuesday by 4:00 p.m. Barricades must be returned to the Department of Public Works within five (5) days of the issuance. Failure to do so will result in the forfeit of the deposit and an additional charge for each missing barricade.

(When closing off streets, do not block street access with a motor vehicle, picnic tables, trash receptacles, etc. Only city issued barricades may be used for this purpose.)

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 04-1001, (Chapter 17), Sections 17-100 through 17-114, entitled, "Block Parties", refers to the rules and regulations governing the City's policy on Block Parties.
