

Inclement Weather Policy

When inclement weather threatens the Dearborn area, **outdoor pools** will respond in the following manner:

- Severe Thunderstorm or Tornado Watch-Patrons will be advised that a “watch” has been issued and that the pool will close if threatening weather develops.
- Severe Thunderstorm or Tornado Warning-Patrons will be advised that a “warning” has been issued and they will be directed by pool personnel to a designated shelter area.
- Lightning- Patrons will be advised that lightning has been detected and that they must vacate the pool, deck and cage area immediately. The pool and deck area will remain closed for 30 minutes following the final lightning or thunder.
- Heavy Rainfall-Patrons will be asked to vacate the pool if heavy rainfall prevents lifeguards from seeing the bottom of the pool.

Outdoor Pool Rental
