Welcome to the Dearborn Ice Skating Center's Learn to Skate Program

This program offers quality instruction on many comprehensive skills using the United States Figure Skating Association guidelines and standards. Professional instructors conduct class in a positive atmosphere, making learning to skate a fun experience for recreational hockey and figure skaters of all ages.

Format: Classes run for 7 weeks. 40 minute classes are held once per week and include 30 minutes of instruction and 10 minutes of supervised practice and or supervised skating games.

1st Day Procedure: Skaters should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to their scheduled class time, allowing sufficient time for preparation. Specific class/instruct assignments will be made on ice after evaluating the student's level

Equipment: Single blade hockey or figure skates are required. Laces are preferred over Velcro or buckles. Helmets are strongly recommended.

Clothing: Comfortable, flexible and warm clothing, including gloves/mittens, are recommended for all skaters. Beginning skaters should wear loose fitting pants for learning to safely fall and stand back up.

Private Instruction: Most instructors on staff offer private instruction. Please consult the instructor of your choice.
