A special display of Civil War style quilts by Julie Hale of Bits ‘n Pieces, historically inspired wedding garments designed and sewn by member, Velda Kirby and cloth dolls by Charlie Patricolo will be exhibited in a historical setting at the McFadden-Ross House. In addition, over 100 quilts made by Society members and the Dearborn Historical Museum’s quilt collection will be on display at the Commandant’s Quarters.
