George Darany sworn in as newest member of the Dearborn City Council

DEARBORN, Mich. – George Darany, a longtime community booster, was sworn in on Tuesday, Jan. 9, as the newest member of the Dearborn City Council.

Darany joined the Council because of a vacancy created on the council when former council president John B. O'Reilly, Jr. become mayor pro tem.

According to the City Charter, the next highest vote-getter in the last council election fills a vacancy. Darany was the eighth highest vote-getter in the 2005 election, after the seven people who won seats on the Council.

Darany is the owner of the Classic Trolley Co., and a realtor with RE/MAX Team 2000.

He belongs to numerous service clubs and community organizations, and has been a City Beautiful Commissioner since 1990, serving as chairman in 2002 and 2003.

His involvement includes serving on the board of directors of the Dearborn Chamber of Commerce and on the board of directors of the Inter Service Club Council. He currently serves on the board of the Dearborn Rotary Club and the Dearborn Goodfellows.

He is a volunteer at Sacred Heart Church and with the Meals on Wheels program, among other organizations. He is a current member of the West Dearborn Business Association.
